Tailor our service to meet your needs.

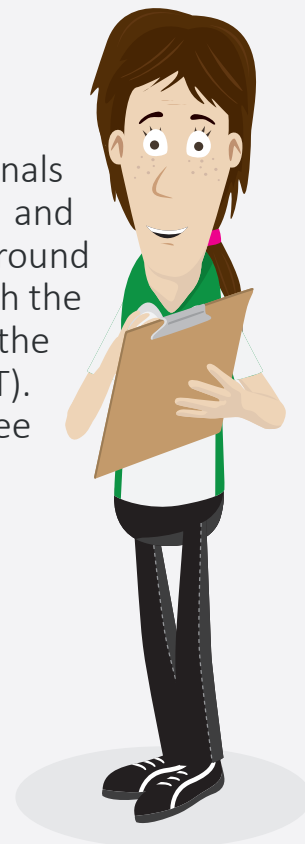

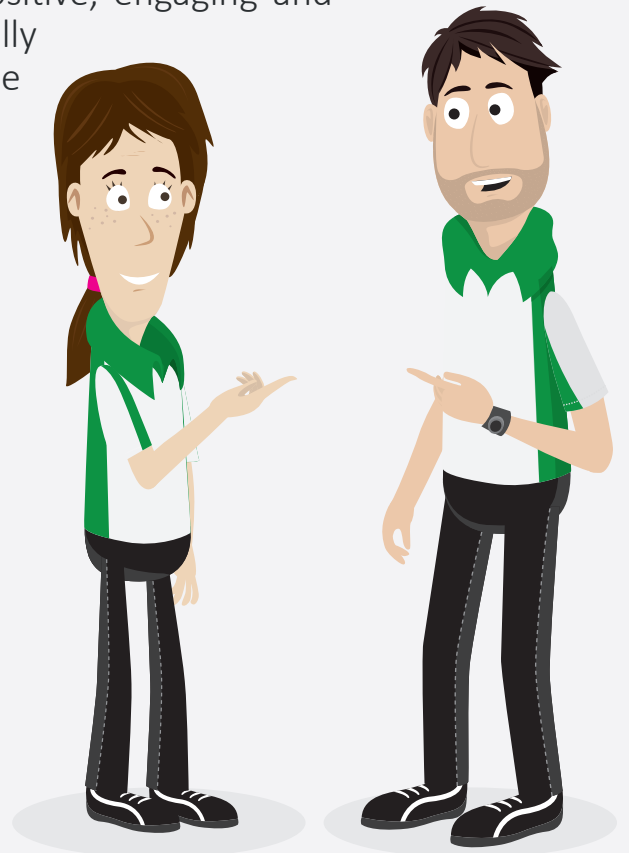

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Occupational Therapy groups in schools...

Our Occupational Therapy groups in schools enable multiple children to be seen by our specialist Occupational Therapists. The groups run over the course of one school day, with up to four groups per day. There are the five different types of group:

- Handwriting group
- Concentration group
- Organisation and memory group
- Fine motor group
- Movement group

Children in each group are assessed and treated over one term and an individual report is provided outlining the progress made, further recommendations to school, and activities that aid in building capacity for staff in your school.

Occupational Therapy groups available in schools...

We have a five types of groups available. These groups are aimed at improving key aspects of a child's performance in school. These include; handwriting, concentration, organisation, fine motor skills, and movement.

Handwriting group.

Each handwriting group aims to improve the legibility, letter formation, sizing, spacing, alignment, letter slope and overall appearance of writing. Activities completed within the handwriting group are designed to improve the underlying hand strength and visual perceptual skills needed for speedy and legible writing.

- ✓ Improve pencil grip
- ✓ Improve posture
- ✓ Improve understanding of size and shape
- ✓ Improve visual perception skills
- ✓ Improve writing speed
- ✓ Improve fluency
- ✓ Improved legibility of writing



Concentration group.

The concentration group is designed to improve visual attention, auditory attention, task attention and address any sensory needs.

- ✓ Improve auditory attention and 'listening' skills
- ✓ Improve visual attention and 'looking' skills
- ✓ Improve processing skills
- ✓ Improve ability to remain seated

Organisation group.

The organisation group is a group designed to improve general 'life skills', including working memory, sequencing, planning and organisation skills. All skills developed aid children in successful participation in school and at home.

Fine motor group.

The fine motor group is designed to improve hand strength, finger manipulation and visuomotor skills. Fine motor activities include cutting, threading and writing.

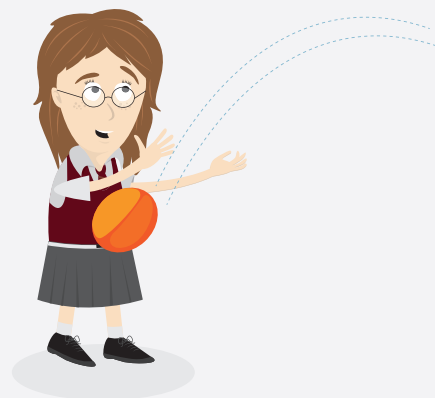

We provide expert training on improving teacher understanding of handwriting, movement, fine motor skills, concentration skills and how Occupational Therapy can benefit schools.

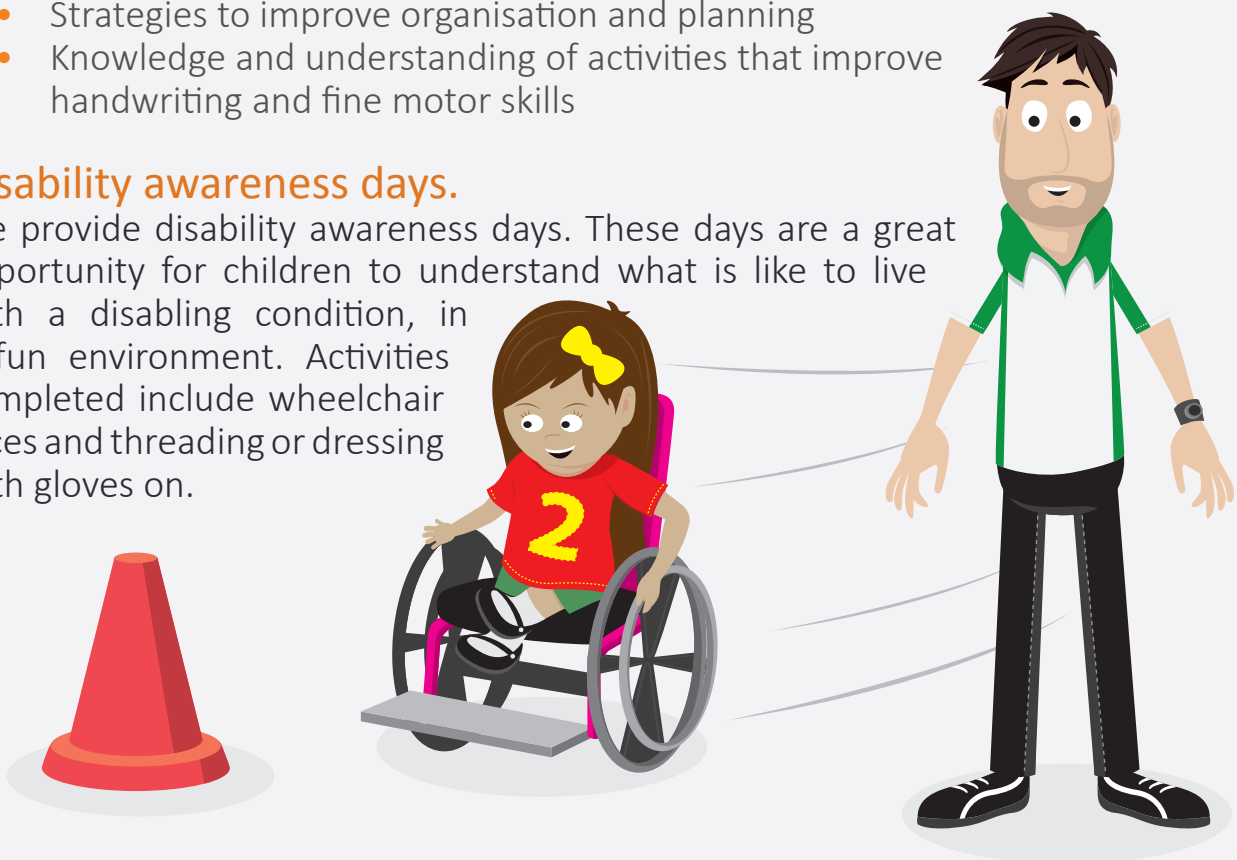
School audits.

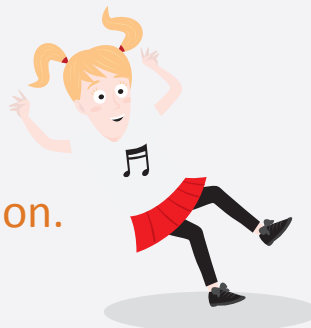

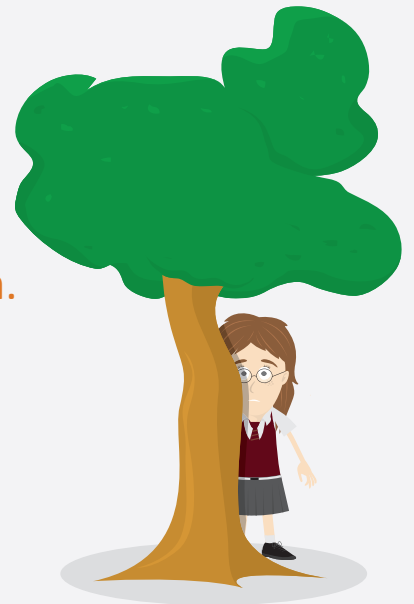

Conditions we treat...

Our Occupational Therapists are able to assess and treat a wide range of conditions including:

Sensory conditions.

We have highly specialised Occupational Therapists who are trained in Sensory Integration and are able to provide effective assessment and treatment of a range of sensory conditions such as ASD, Sensory Processing Disorder and Acquired Brain Injury.

Neurological and long term conditions.

We assess and treat a wide range of neurological conditions. Our therapists help improve key skills such as writing, concentration and co-ordination. Conditions we work with include Stroke, Cerebral Palsy, Acquired Brain Injury, Down's Syndrome, hydrocephalus and Multiple Sclerosis.

Mental health.

We work with children who have mental health difficulties and those who are struggling with conditions such as anxiety and depression, low self esteem, and self harm. We provide effective and long lasting changes to the wellbeing of children with mental health difficulties.

Cognitive difficulties.

We assess, treat and improve a range of cognitive difficulties such as poor organisation, short term memory and concentration. Cognitive difficulties can be as a result of a range of medical conditions, including stroke, acquired brain injury, cancer, hydrocephalus, Cerebral Palsy, dyspraxia and developmental delay.

Physical conditions.

We assess and treat physical conditions such as poor fine motor skills, handwriting problems, and gross motor co-ordination difficulties.

Meet Jimmy...

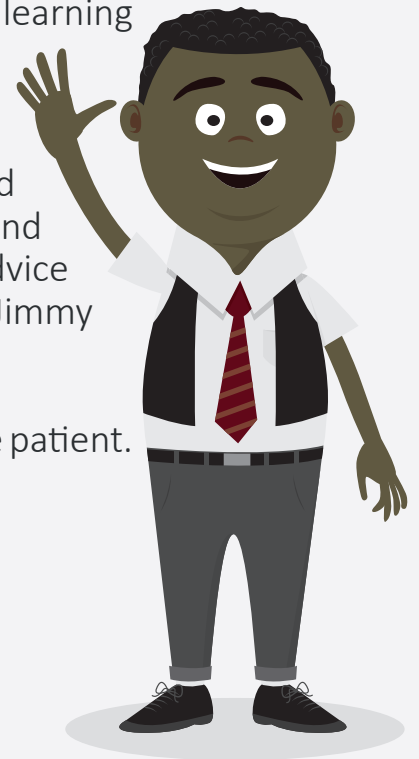
Jimmy is 10 years old, he enjoys playing football and wants to do well at school. Jimmy has dyspraxia, or developmental co-ordination disorder. Dyspraxia is a well known condition, however the association between the condition and how it can affect a child at school is not so well understood. Dyspraxia affects a child's planning, processing, and motor co-ordination, which dramatically impacts upon a child's performance in school.

Jimmy struggles to ride a bike, he is never picked for the school football team, and the teachers at his school are expressing concerns regarding his writing. Jimmy tries very hard to keep up with the class when he is copying from the board, however he just can't keep up. He has to concentrate so hard on making his writing neat and legible, that he often misses the information being taught and the objectives for the lesson.

Jimmy came to our clinic and received an initial assessment and ongoing monthly treatment. Alongside his ongoing treatment, Jimmy and his parents worked through a home programme of activities to improve his skills, and Caroline, his Occupational Therapist, visited his school to improve his environment and increase his learning opportunities .

Over time, Jimmy's writing became legible and he was able to kick a football with good accuracy and he even managed to get his way onto the school football team! Both Jimmy and his parents were extremely pleased with the support, advice and expert help they received from OT for Kids in helping Jimmy achieve his goals.
